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SELECTIVE/SCHOLARSHIP ENTRY TEST – EXTERNAL - 2010

We provide this information as you are likely to be interested in the programme which prepares students for the Selective High Entrance Examination and/or the ACER Private Schools Scholarship test. The lessons will start in the week beginning April 19th 2010. Students will attend once each week (school holidays excluded) right through to the examinations early in 2011. Classes will operate:

The cost for the full period of the course will be set at \$49.50 per lesson (GST inclusive) for a weekday, and \$55.00 per lesson (GST inclusive) for a weekend lesson. There will be no additional charges. Students will only be accepted at the start of the course; no late enrolments are possible. As the lessons are designed to be sequential, gradually building on skills, it is not possible to rejoin the programme after a period of absence. Lessons are designed to improve exam technique, speed, accuracy, concentration as well as providing development of skills for typical questions and sample tests in Comprehension, Maths, General Ability and Writing. Further information will be provided to parents when they attend for the test.

It is the policy of this company to admit to these programmes only those students who are intellectually suited. Competence in English comprehension and writing and in Mathematics must be demonstrated. Our entry assessment will consist of four 25 minute tests (Comprehension, Mathematics, General Ability and Writing). Students will be fully supervised for the exam period. There will be a short break between the tests during which fruit will be served. The entry assessment will be used to determine suitability for admission as well as providing staff with a record of each student's strengths and weaknesses. These scores are also used to determine the initial grading of the classes. Parents will be provided with raw statistical information within a week of the assessment. For those who are accepted and complete enrolment procedures, more detailed comparative statistics will be provided in the early weeks of the course.

If you are interested in your child joining these classes, then you will need to book for an assessment session. The successful students who are tested in the earlier sessions will have a greater range of days and times available for choice of classes. Note that an invitation to attend this assessment does not indicate that acceptance into the programme will be automatic. Please post, deliver or fax the attached application to our office. There is a charge of \$45, which must accompany the application. Confirmations will be issued and entry to assessment sessions will only be available to those producing their confirmation.
